Getting to Gilwell Park

A detailed local map is attached should you be arriving by road. If you chose to come by taxi it may be useful for the taxi driver!

You may wish to use the Transport for London website to have them plot your journey related to you anticipated arrival times to London. Go to:

This is an excellent site, easy to use.

Arriving at Stansted Airport

Stansted is located North-East of Gilwell Park. A taxi will cost minimum £50 (estimate).

The airport is located above its dedicated railway station. Catch the Stanstead Express (runs every 30 minutes) to Tottenham Hale Station. Get an inclusive ticket – ask for a ticket to Chingford. This avoids having to queue a second time at Tottenham Hale.

Transfer to Underground, taking the Victoria Line service northbound to Walthamstow Central station.

Exit underground system.

Take surface train northbound to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

Arriving at London City Airport

London City Airport is located adjacent to Docklands Light Railway.

Purchase a ticket for all zones – about £8.00

Take the railway in the direction of Bank and go to the terminus of this service.

Transfer to Bank Underground station, Central Line (this involves a lot of walking).

Take the eastbound Central Central Line service to Liverpool Street Station.

Exit the Underground system.

Take a surface train northbound to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

Arriving at London Gatwick Airport

You may take a taxi at a minimum of £70-100.

Gatwick Airport is located on top of its own railway station.

Purchase a ticket that includes a day pass to all Zones.

You may use either the Gatwick Express or regular services to Victoria. The timing is very similar, but Gatwick Express is twice as expensive.

At Victoria station, follow signs for Underground and use the same ticket to enter the Victoria Line.

Take this service northbound to its end – Walthamstow Central.

Exit the Underground system.

Take a surface train to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

Arriving at London Luton Airport

You may take a taxi at a minimum of £100.

There is a free transfer from the airport to Luton Parkway station.

Purchase an inclusive ticket to include all Zones.

Take the train southbound to Kings Cross City Link station.

Exit this station and follow signs for Kings Cross Underground station – about 500m.

Take Victoria Line northbound to Walthamstow Central.

Exit the Underground system.

Take a surface train northbound to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

Arriving at London Heathrow Airport

Taking a taxi will cost in excess of £100.

There are a number of routes:

1 – using the Underground

Purchase a one day travel card for all Zones, or a one way journey to Chingford.

Take the Piccadilly Line eastbound to Finsbury Park. (26/27 stops – 45 mins -1hour)

Change to the (adjacent) Victoria Line northbound to Walthamstow Central.

Exit the Underground system.

Take a surface train northbound to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

2 – using Heathrow Express and then Underground – more expensive

Purchase a ticket before entering the station. It may be possible to get an inclusive ticket – Heathrow Express and travel Card for all Zones.

Take Heathrow Express from its dedicated station (follow signs) to Paddington Station. (15 minutes)

Enter the Underground system, District/Circle Lines eastbound to Kings Cross station.

Follow the signs for Victoria Line and take the service northbound to Walthamstow Central.

Exit the Underground system.

Take a surface train northbound to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

Arriving at St Pancras International on Eurostar

Follow signs for the Underground.

Purchase a ticket to Chingford.

Enter the Underground, Victoria Line, northbound to Walthamstow Central.

Exit the Underground system.

Take a surface train northbound to Chingford.

Take taxi for the final 2 km to Gilwell Park.

By Rail, Nearest station is Chingford.

Heathrow Airport
 Follow signs onto the M4 at junction 4 and travel west to join the M25 at junction 15. Travel north around the M25 to junction 26. From here follow detailed map below.

Stansted Airport

Follow signs onto the M11 at junction 8 and travel south to join the M25 at junction 27. Travel anticlockwise around the M25 to junction 26. From here follow detailed map below.
