

# (i) Programme

82 evaluations received out of 134 participants (61,2%)


1. <u>To what extent do you feel you achieved what you wanted to achieve during the Academy?</u>




2. <u>The most useful sessions for the future work of the participants in their organisations</u>




3. <u>The least useful sessions for the future work of the participants in their organisations</u>

### Comments made by the participants:


- \* "The Academy changed me, made me feel different. And I learned so much from it."

sounded really interesting. An afternoon off to relax and/or explore the surroundings would have been nice as the week was very intense."




#### 1. Did you use Academy website?

16,25% of the participants have provided comments related to communication.


### Comments made by participants:

- \* "More information about the goals and topics of the sessions provided on before hand by the facilitators."


## (iii) Logistics
