In the reporting period, the following actions have been implemented:

AC 1.1 AC 1.2 Support NSOs/NSAs

- A meeting with Organisation of Bulgarian Scouts was realized. The meeting was used for identification of future plans for development of Scouting in Bulgaria, and for defining support that will have to be provided by the ESR.
- A visit to CNGEI was realized in April. The purpose of the visit was a meeting with members of their national board to debate their present organisational framework, the challenges they are facing and some possible directions they could consider taking.

AC 2.1 Help to Finalise the Global Support Assessment Tool

- Assessment of the Guides and Scouts of Finland with use of the Global Support Assessment Tool was realized
- Assessment of the Scout Association of Croatia with use of the Global Support Assessment Tool was realized
- A single process seems to be accepted by all Regions now. The tool has been piloted with some countries (including Finland and Croatia) and seems to be really helpful for assessing needs.

AC 2.2 Promote Global Support

Global Support was promoted at Training Commissioners Network Meeting, held in Porto.

AC 2.3 Evaluation and sharing of GS provided

 Members of the ODCG have started to work on the Guidelines for effective monitoring of the Global Support

AC 3.2a Management of the Consultancy Pool

All volunteers that have not respond even to the second call for responding were marked as not available or not interested and will not be taken into consideration in the future management of the database.
