Where will Roverway be held?

More than 100 sites are being identified in partnership with local Scouts, 100 6-days paths across every region of France - this is the challenge of Roverway 2016,.

One site has already been identified by the Roverway team. It is the "Scouts of the World" Centre in Jambville, in the department of les Yvelines, an hour from Paris. This campsite of over 50 hectares will also host the main Roverway camp from 10-14 August 2016. The Jambville team are really excited to be part of the event!

How much?

Roverway 2016 has put in place a support plan to estimate the event cost for each participant. It will set a price for each contingent based on their country's GDP. On our initial estimate, the price will be on a scale between 290 and 540 euros.

For the IST (International Service Team), there will be a fixed price of 290 euros for the whole of Roverway (paths and camp). Full details of the support plan will be communicated and explained to NSO/MOs in November 2014 via the first information bulletin.

IN EUROPE

Roverway 2016 and the World Scout Moot 2017 met for the first time on Tuesday 13th May. Louis Marbach, International Relations Coordinator for Roverway 2016 and Hrönn Pétursdóttir, Chief Moot Camp, discussed a number of common aspects and our respective needs. Our Icelandic friends, hosts of Roverway 2009, have a lot of experience in preparing paths. We have much to learn from each other and will develop a true partnership to support our teams in delivering two very successful events.

ROVERWAY PREPARATION: HEAD OF CONTINGENT

Roverway 2016 organisers would like to invite all National Scout Organisation and WAG-GGS Member Organisation of the European Regions of WOSM and WAGGGS to appoint the Head of their national Contingent for Roverway 2016 for the end of september 2014.

What is the role of a "Head of Contingent"?

A Head of Contingent (HoC) is the official representative of Roverway 2016 in his/her association. The HoC will introduce and promote Roverway, encourage Rovers and Rangers to participate and coordinate the creation of a national contingent for the event. After the nomination, the HoC will act as an official link between the Roverway organization and the NSO/MO. Here are the key missions of the HoC:

- Establishing the key educational objectives for the Contingent
- Liaising with the event organizers in France
- Overseeing the marketing and recruitment of the Contingent
- Overseeing the preparations for the Contingent
- Leading the Contingent during their time in France

HoC should have a good and smooth relationship with the International Commissioner as well as with the National Rover/Ranger Commissioner.

During Roverway, the HoC will be a member of the International Service Team, serving in the role of an 'ambassador' at the Roverway Office and participating in HoC meetings.

Who can become a Head of Contingent?

The Head of Contingent will be appointed by the NSO/MO

He/she should be a dedicated leader who has some experience in international activities and has preferably participated in a camp abroad before

The person should be at least 23 years old at Roverway opening dates

He/she needs to be able to communicate in English

Access to the Internet and familiarity in communicating online are essential

The position takes some time but, in return, gives a memorable experience for a lifetime.

Once the HoC have been nominated, she/he must remain in place until the event in 2016. 2 "HoC meetings" will be organized:

28-29 and 30th of November 2014 in Jambville (the place where the Roverway central camp will be organized)

in August or September 2015

For communication purposes and to avoid the multiplication of intermediates, Roverway will only recognize one HoC per country. This does not exclude the fact that inside a contingent, each association can nominate one person to manage its group.
