Erasmus+ Call for Partners for the Network Meeting 2015

Dear Friends,

This circular provides you with information on the Erasmus+ project application for the Network Meeting 2015 to which your NSO, NSA, MO or CA can be partner. To be able to be a partner in this project, please check carefully the rules below and follow all the steps described. This year the application will be submitted at national level in Belgium by the Europe Region WAGGGS.

Description and objectives of the Network Meeting 2015

The Network Meeting is a yearly appointment for Guides and Scouts that are representing their NSOs/NSAs, MOs/CAs in various platforms/organizations including their National Youth Councils.

In 2015 the Network Meeting will particularly target Guides and Scouts that are working in the field of external relations, communication, partnerships or other closely related areas from NSOs/NSAs, MOs/CAs having none or little experience in this field of work.

The event will offer the opportunity to gather, explore how conducting external relations can help associations to better fulfil the Scouting and Guiding mission and to improve their position and recognition in society, in collaboration with other national partners.

The event is open to Guides and Scouts from Member Organisations/Component Associations of WAGGGS and National Scout Organisations/National Scout Associations of WOSM European Regions.

The Network Meeting will take place in Porto (PT) from 26th to 29th October 2015.

Participants are expected to arrive on 25th October and leave from 30th October.

Part of the meeting will be held simultaneously with the Academy but will have its own programme. If any participant wishes join the Academy as from the 30th October, please note that any expense related to the Academy should be covered by the NSO/NSA/MO/CA.

How to benefit from this grant opportunity?

1. Register your NSO/NSA/MO/CA to get your PIC number

If you still have not registered your organisation to receive your PIC number, you should do it following the instructions attached to this circular.

Please note that all the documents requested in the instructions should be uploaded in your PIC registration. If you are not able to prove your legal entity, the national agency might refuse to consider your organisation as a partner to the project.

2. Complete the relevant information for each application

After you receive your PIC number, please fill in all the relevant information in the **document Part C** enclosed.

Please be accurate in your answers. This information will be then directly copy-pasted into the application and therefore, this information will be evaluated as part of the assessment of the entire project.

What kind of support will you benefit from?

✓ Reduced Travel costs

The reimbursement will be done based on a lump sum calculated on the travel distance for each participant:

For travel distances between 100km and 499km: EUR 180 per participant

For travel distances between 500km and 1999km: EUR 275 per participant

For travel distances between 2000km and 2999km: EUR 360 per participant

For travel distances between 3000km and 3999km: EUR 530 per participant

For travel distances between 4000km and 7999km: EUR 820 per participant

For travel distances of 8000km and more: EUR 1100 per participant

For the purpose of the application, please note that all the distances will be calculated from the capital of your country. If you wish to indicate another departure point, please contact Stefania Francescon at stefania@europe.wagggsworld.org.
