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# Invitation International Commissioners' Forum

15 - 17 January 2016, Gdansk, Poland

# Aim of the Forum

The aim of the forum is to provide a venue for International Commissioners to share and gain information on the important roles they play in the life of their associations.

#### **Objectives**

For a new IC:

- To understand what the Regions and other NSOs/MOs expect from ICs
- To understand more about the Regions
- To exchange experiences
- To learn from other, more experienced, ICs
- To get to know other ICs and start forming a network
- To get an introduction into the European Conferences
- To get an idea about the things which are important for experienced ICs (see below)

## For an experienced IC:

- To broaden their network
- To share best practices on:
  - how to introduce topics from the Regions/World level into the NSO/MO
  - how to introduce international topics into the programme of the NSO/MO
  - how to organise international work (how to work with an international team, how to divide the work etc.)
  - $\circ~$  how to prepare units going abroad etc.
- To take an active role in the work of the Regions (by inputting preparations for the conferences, evaluating work done)
- To be aware of the political issues in the Regions and at World level and to actively contribute to policy and representation issues

# For the Regions:

- To get feedback from the ICs
- To involve ICs in the work of the Regions
- To "promote" the Regions, their work and joint work
- To consult on the current regional plans and future developments

## **Participants profile**

- International Commissioners
- Members of International Teams (with the agreement of the relevant International Commissioner)
- Able to communicate well in English

## Dates

The forum will be held from 15 -17 January. Participants should arrive in time to start the programme at 09.00 on Friday January 15. Accommodation will be arranged from Thursday till Sunday inclusive and meals will commence with breakfast on Friday.

Departures should be planned for after 12.30 on Sunday 17 January.

## Additional meeting on the 14<sup>th</sup>

On Thursday 14 January an additional WAGGGS only day will be organized by WAGGGS. The main topic that will be discussed will be related to the direction that WAGGGS is moving in - which includes the strategy of the Europe Region, value proposition work, Growth and more. This is an interesting opportunity for all WAGGGS IC's to be part of this discussion also in preparation for the Europe Region Conference to be held in June 2016. More specific details on the extra WAGGGS day will be sent at a later stage.

Participants should arrive in time to start the programme at 9:00 on Thursday the 14<sup>th</sup> of January.



## Venue

The forum will be held at the <u>European Solidarnosc</u> <u>Center</u> and participants will be accommodated at the <u>Scandic Hotel</u>, located in the centre of Gdansk.

The standard forum fee is based on two people sharing a room. However it is possible to request a single room at additional cost.

The venue provides free wireless internet access.

## Language

The forum will be held in English.

#### Working methods

Guiding and Scouting methods will be used during the forum. This includes learning by doing, working in small groups, exercises, plenary and informal discussion.

There will be ample opportunities for informal networking.

Participants are encouraged to actively participate in offering a topic to share with others. Additional information on the programme will be provided in further communications.

#### Programme

The Planning and Host Team is in the process of preparing an interesting and relevant programme to stimulate international understanding, policy discussions, sharing projects etc. Active participation by everyone is encouraged and already participants, MOs and NSOs are encouraged to contact the team to provide projects to be shared, best practices to be explored, and learning to be shared.

#### Communication

## **Participation fee**

The forum is a self-financed event. Participants who have difficulties with the fee and travelling costs should contact either Regional Office to request information on the possibility of financial assistance from the Regions.

The participation fee relates to the kind of accommodation required and to the duration of the stay, with a standard fee based on two people sharing a room arriving on the  $14^{th}$  of January and leaving on the  $17^{th}$ .

Standard participation fee (a bed in twin room): 275 Euros.

1 day more, single	Check in on the 13 <sup>th</sup> – Check out on the 17 <sup>th</sup>	475€

Applications submitted after the deadline (30 November) will be subject of an additional charge of 50 Euros.

No application will be accepted after 15 December.

Fees will be invoiced directly to the participants' Associations.

## Visa

The participants are responsible for organising their travel and obtaining a visa if necessary. Please be aware, that it may take up to six weeks to obtain a visa.
