Background

The Network Meeting of External Communication Commissioners is a first event of its kind. It stems from the demand of individual NSOs and from the importance of the topic of public image of Scouting as perceived by the European Scout Region. It addresses issues of common interest to External Communication Commissioners and other people who are directly involved at the national level in supporting the public image of Scouting.

Aim

Dates

Programme overview

Participant profile

The primary target group are the External Communication Commissioners operating at National level, leaders of national teams on public image of Scouting or people in similar positions with strategic and decision making capabilities, both volunteers and professionals.

Number of participants

We will accept up to two participants from a National Scout Association. Priority will be given to have the largest number of different countries represented.

Travel arrangements

Once participants have been approved, they will receive all the travel information and a travel form. After that, they should make their own travel arrangements and obtain a visa, if necessary.

Participation fee

The participation fee is €200. The fee covers full programme (including accommodation, meals, social programme, and event materials) from 31 March to 3 April 2016. The fee does not cover any travel costs to the venue.

The standard accommodation is in twin, three bedded or four bedded rooms.

Invoice of the event will be sent directly to the sending NSO/NSA once the participant is confirmed.

Insurance

The Region does not provide insurance for participants during the event nor during the travel to or from the venue. Please note that this is the exclusive responsibility of the national association to check and be sure that the participants are covered by insurance.
