Erasmus + Call for Partners for Two Projects

Dear friends,

This circular provides you with information on the next two Erasmus + application for which your NSO/NSA can be partner: the Partnership Event 2017 and 2018 and Agora 2017.

To be able to be a partner in this project proposal, please check carefully the requirements below and follow all the steps described. The application will be submitted at national level by the hosting NSOs.

Description and Objectives of these projects

1) Partnership Event, Belgium, March 2017 and Denmark, March 2018

The Partnership Event is the annual meeting of the Partnership Network, a coalition of Scout and Guide Associations, which aims at fostering, strengthening and developing new partnerships between associations of Scouts and Guides in Europe and associations from other parts of the world. The overall idea of the network is to share and create information about on-going partnerships, as well as to provide a platform for the exchange of experiences and knowledge. A continuous reflection on the relevance of partnerships, as well as the promotion of inter-cultural understanding and mutual respect are central elements of the Partnership Network.

The Partnership Event 2017 and 2018 will provide space for ideas on how to build and reinforce existing partnerships and also further develop multilateral approaches, such as the UNGUVU project. In 2017 the event will have, for the first time, a special regional focus on the Asia-Pacific Region of WOSM and WAGGGS. NSOs/NSAs and MOs/CAs from Asia-Pacific will be invited to participate in order to strengthen dialogue and partnerships.

What kind of support you will benefit from?

The reimbursement will be done based on a lump sum calculated on the travel distance for each participant. For travel distances between:

100 and 499 KM: 180 EUR per participant 500 and 1999 KM: 275 EUR per participant 2000 and 2999 KM: 360 EUR per participant 3000 and 3999 KM: 530 EUR per participant
