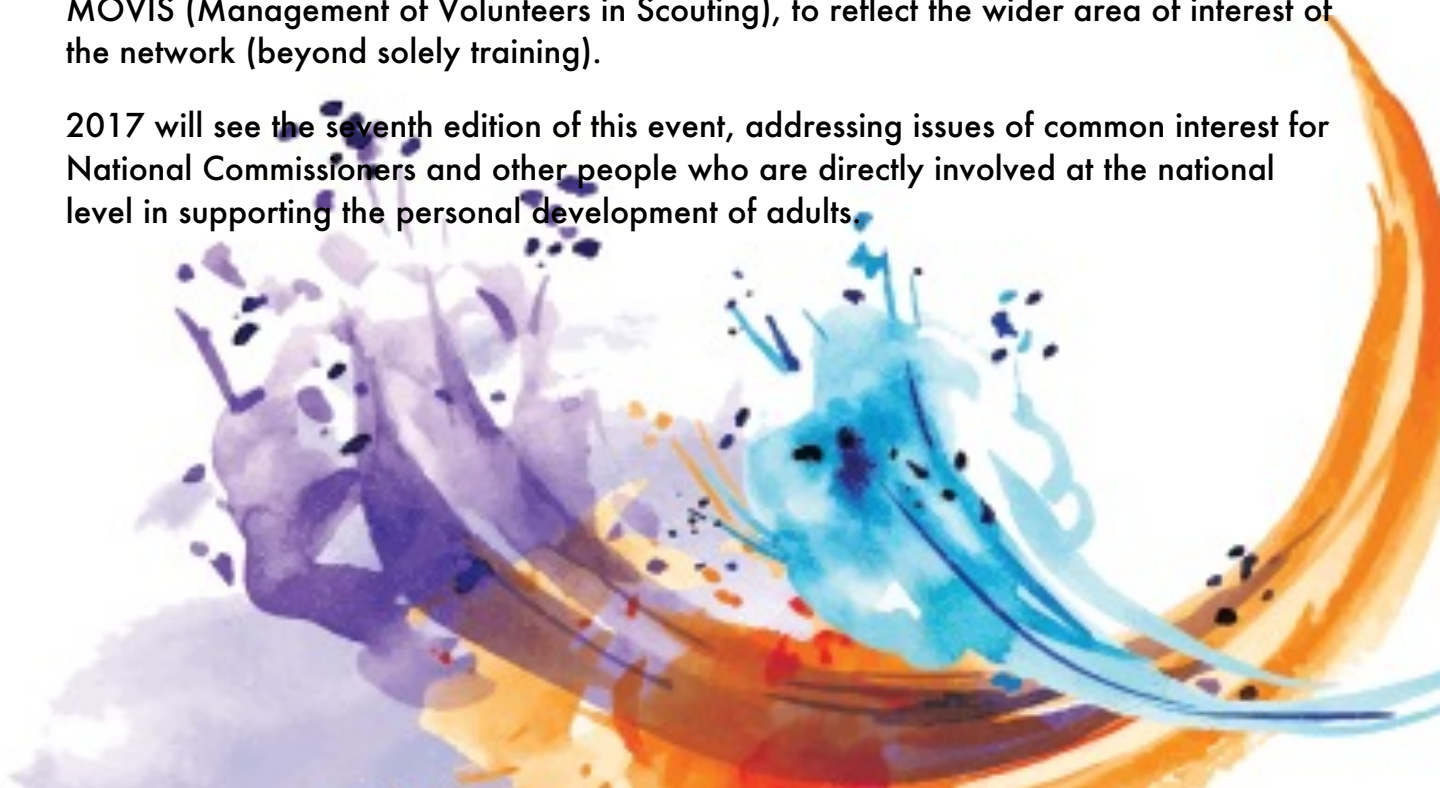

Official Invitation

The Networking Meeting of commissioners involved in the management of adult resources is one of the well-known and successful networking opportunities for national leaders in the European Region. Formerly known under the acronym TCNM (standing for the Training Commissioners Network Meeting) it has lately updated its name to MOVIS (Management of Volunteers in Scouting), to reflect the wider area of interest of the network (beyond solely training).

2017 will see the seventh edition of this event, addressing issues of common interest for National Commissioners and other people who are directly involved at the national level in supporting the personal development of adults.



Aim

The aim of the meeting is to offer a motivating and informative opportunity for experts on the management and support of adult volunteers to share experiences and learn from each other.

Objectives

- Offer an opportunity for effective **networking and partnerships**
- Inspire participants to use **innovative methods to implement MoViS**
- Focus the sharing and discussions on the **topics defined in the Regional Scout Plan**: online tools, recognition of competencies and the implementation of World Policies (Youth Programme, Adult Resources, Youth Involvement, Leadership in Scouting)

Dates

Participants are requested to arrive on **Thursday, 07 December 2017**, before 20:00. Departures are from **Sunday, 10 December 2017**, starting at 11:00.

Venue

The event will take place at "Residencia Salesiana Marti Codolar", a historic landmark in Barcelona, the capital city of Catalonia. Since the XV century, farmers, Hieronymite monks, and members of the bourgeoisie have settled in this farm. The latter embellished it to turn it into a summer residence.

The standard accommodation is in twin and three-bedded rooms.

Participants should be able to communicate well in English.

Programme overview

The programme overview will be published on the event website and updated based on the contributions from the participants, starting from mid-September 2017

Participants profile

The primary target group are the National Commissioners for Adult Resources, Training and/or Volunteers' Management, as well as other people who are directly responsible at national level in supporting the management and personal development of adult volunteers in Scouting.

Number of participants

The event can accommodate a maximum of **65 participants**. Priority will be given to participants from associations which have signed a partnership agreement for the project with the Region.

Applications and travel arrangements

The application form should be completed online on the event website: <http://movis.network/registration/>

It will be available **until 1 November 2017**. To confirm the support of the association, the National Office or International Commissioner will be contacted.

After confirmation, participants will receive detailed travel information and they should make their own travel arrangements and obtain a visa, if necessary.

Participation fee

The standard participation fee is **€ 250**. The fee covers full programme (including accommodation, meals, social programme, and event materials) from 7 to 10 December. The fee does not cover any travel costs to the venue.

The fee for participants from National Scout Associations which have signed a partnership agreement for this project is **€ 150**. Additionally, a grant to support the travel for them is available – the necessary details regarding all this was already communicated to the partner associations.

Bank details for paying the participation fee will be provided to participants upon registration.

Insurance

The Region does not provide insurance for participants during the event nor during the travel to or from the venue. Please note that this is the exclusive responsibility of the national association to check and be sure that the participants are covered by

insurance.
