### Regional Circular 25 2017

Dear Friends,

We are very happy to share with you some updates regarding the implementation of the European Regional Scout Plan 2016-2019 in the "Spreading our Message" area of operation under the "Communication" priority.

#### 1) Changes in the social media channels

First of all, let us announce some changes in the social media channels currently used by the European Scout Region. Starting from 11 October 2017 the <u>names</u> of the "EuroScoutInfo" Twitter account, as well as "EuroScoutInfo" Facebook page have been changed to "**Scouting in Europe**".

"Scouting in Europe" on Facebook will remain the European Scout Region's platform for sharing regular news, with a focus on updates and information on the main themes of the Regional Scout Plan (https://www.facebook.com/ScoutinginEurope/). "Scouting in Europe" on Twitter will change its focus towards strategic engagement and external relations – external communication and interactions with the external partners (institutions) (https://twitter.com/ScoutingEurope).

Both changes have been discussed with the World Scout Bureau and are in line with the future communication plan and work undertaken by the world level.

#### 2) Assessment of the methods of communication currently used by the Region

Both above-mentioned changes are also a part of a broader <u>action to develop and implement of a new</u> <u>communication system of the Region</u>.
