We are seeking a graphic design to develop a publication that features highlights and milestones of the project.

Deliverables

- Designing the layout of publication (a booklet of about 20 pages)
- Conceptualizing, proposing and designing graphic elements for the project web page

Timeframe

The publication needs to be completed for printing by November 15th at the latest.

Required skills and expertise

- Background in communication, graphic design or similar fields;
- Demonstrable design skills with a good portfolio;
- Advanced proficiency in Adobe Suite tools (Illustrator, Photoshop, InDesign);
- Very good knowledge of English;
- Flexibility with working hours;

- Experience in front-end web development (HTML/CSS/JS);
- Knowledge of Scouting and its projects
- Interest in refugee and migration, youth empowerment and human rights.
- Experience with UI, UX and web design
